

## **Emergency Cash Grants for College Students Impacted By COVID-19**

U.S. Secretary of Education Betsy DeVos has authorized direct emergency cash grants to college students whose lives and education have been disrupted by the coronavirus outbreak. This funding is available through the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund authorized by the *Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act*, signed into law by President Donald J. Trump.

The Emergency Cash Grants are to be used for expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to the coronavirus such as course materials and technology needed to participate in online classes as well as food, housing, health care, and childcare.

Grant amounts will be calculated based on students remaining hours to complete their program from March 17, 2020 and the student's eligibility for the Federal Pell Grant program for the 2019-2020 award year. Grants will be disbursed in at least 2 payments.
